STOCK MARKET

The VN-Index continued to close down by nearly 6 points today. Market breadth leaned negative with 11 out of 18 sectors declining, led by Information Technology, followed by Insurance and Oil & Gas. In terms of foreign trading, net selling was recorded across all three exchanges: HSX, HNX, and UPCOM. The SMA10 and SMA20 are still providing fairly solid support for the market. The sideways trend shows no signs of ending yet. A notable event for tomorrow: September 19 is expected to mark the completion date of ETF portfolio rebalancing.

FUTURES CONTRACTS

Futures contracts all decreased according to the movement of VN30.

COVERED WARRANTS

During the trading session on 18/09/2025, warrants fluctuated according to the struggling movement of the underlying stocks.

HIGHLIGHT

- VN-Index -5.79 points, closing at 1665.18 points. HNX-Index -0.71 points, closing at 276.92 points.
- Pulling the index up: VIC (+1.74), VHM (+0.57), STB (+0.35), HVN (+0.23), VIX (+0.18).
- Pulling the index down: VCB (-1.73), FPT (-0.97), VNM (-0.71), ACB (-0.70), GAS (-0.54).
- The matched trade value of VN-Index reached VND 25,460 billion, decreased -13.79% compared to the previous session. The total transaction value reached VND 27,827 billion.
- The trading range is 34.05 points. The market had 108 gainers, 60 remaining unchanged, 208 losers.
- Foreign investors' net selling value: VND -1512.46 billion on HOSE, including VIC (VND -212.85 billion), VHM (VND -132.03 billion), SSI (VND -123.43 billion), VIX (VND -121.45 billion), MSN (VND -89.24 billion). Foreign investors were net sellers on HNX with the value of VND -98.62 billion.

- VN30 -7.11 points, closing at 1861.74 points. The trading range was 46.36 points. FPT, ACB, VNM, VJC, VPB impacted negatively on VN30
- VN30 lost momentum from the end of the morning session. The index closed in red with liquidity continuing to fall below the MA20 line. In the short term, the market may continue to fluctuate before determining long-term trends. Investors are advised to trade cautiously in the coming sessions.
- Futures contracts all decreased according to the movement of VN30. In terms of volume, futures contracts increased, except for VN30F2509.





The BSC50 portfolio includes 50 companies selected based on liquidity criteria among the 100 best liquid stocks on all three exchanges. These stocks have a higher beta than BSC30, but are still among the top companies in Banking, Securities, Insurance, Construction, Real Estate, Materials, Logisitic, O&G, F&B, Retail, Industrial Production, and Utilities (Electricity, Water), etc. BSC 50 is evaluated quarterly by BSC experts to ensure that the stocks still meet the given criteria. The BSC50 listing is suitable for bull market periods and has potential for investors looking for short-term trading opportunities.
