

#### STOCK MARKET

The VN-Index traded sideways within the 1,765–1,775 range throughout the day before closing at 1,757.95, down slightly by more than 3 points compared to the previous session. Market breadth was negative with 11 out of 18 sectors declining, led by the Information Technology sector. On the other hand, the Industrial Goods & Services sector recorded the strongest gain, while other sectors showed little change. Regarding foreign investors' activity, they were net sellers on HSX and HNX, while slightly net buyers on UPCOM. In the coming sessions, the VN-Index may continue to move sideways to build a base for a potential rebound, while awaiting further positive developments from the market. Tomorrow is the derivatives expiration session; investors should exercise caution as the market may experience volatility.

#### **FUTURES CONTRACTS**

All futures contracts rose, moving in the opposite direction of the VN30 Index.

#### **COVERED WARRANTS**

During the trading session on 15/10/2025, warrants fluctuated according to the struggling movement of the underlying stocks.

- VN-Index -3.11 points, closing at 1757.95 points. HNX-Index +0.79 points, closing at 276.12 points.
- Pulling the index up: VPB (+2.26), VJC (+1.54), GEE (+0.97), GEX (+0.91), KDH (+0.61).
- Pulling the index down: VHM (-2.76), VIC (-2.11), VCB (-1.14), VPL (-1.12), FPT (-1.06).
- The matched trade value of VN-Index reached VND 35,504 billion, decreased -27.53% compared to the previous session. The total transaction value reached VND 38,015 billion.
- The trading range is 23.33 points. The market had 120 gainers, 54 remaining unchanged, 200 losers.
- Foreign investors' net selling value: VND -832.10 billion on HOSE, including FPT (VND -419.72 billion), KDH (VND -262.43 billion), HDB (VND -169.88 billion), VIC (VND -80.12 billion), VGC (VND -76.68 billion). Foreign investors were net sellers on HNX with the value of VND -68.69 billion.

- VN30 -4.05 points, closing at 2009.64 points. The trading range was 22.30 points. FPT, VIC, VHM, MWG, VRE impacted negatively on VN30.
- Selling pressure pulled VN30 to close below reference with liquidity decreasing compared to the previous session but still maintained above MA20. The strategy is Long/Short flexible with derivatives.
- All futures contracts rose, moving in the opposite direction of the VN30 Index. In terms of volume, futures contracts decreased, except for 41I1FB000.





The BSC50 portfolio includes 50 companies selected based on liquidity criteria among the 100 best liquid stocks on all three exchanges. These stocks have a higher beta than BSC30, but are still among the top companies in Banking, Securities, Insurance, Construction, Real Estate, Materials, Logisitic, O&G, F&B, Retail, Industrial Production, and Utilities (Electricity, Water), etc. BSC 50 is evaluated quarterly by BSC experts to ensure that the stocks still meet the given criteria. The BSC50 listing is suitable for bull market periods and has potential for investors looking for short-term trading opportunities.







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
