



## STOCK MARKET

The VN-Index continued to trade in a narrow range between 1,679 and 1,697 today and closed at 1,690.99 points, up nearly 7 points from yesterday. Seven out of eighteen sectors advanced, with Real Estate and Travel & Leisure leading the gains. In contrast, Information Technology and Industrials posted the largest declines. The number of declining stocks exceeded that of gainers, indicating that improving sentiment is not broad-based. Foreign investors were net buyers on the HSX and HNX, while remaining net sellers on UPCoM. In the coming sessions, the VN-Index will need a directional candle along with supportive liquidity to break above 1,700; otherwise, the market may be vulnerable to unpredictable pullbacks as it trades within the resistance zone.

#### **FUTURES CONTRACTS**

Futures contracts increased according to the movement of VN30, except for 41I1G1000, 41I1G6000.

### **COVERED WARRANTS**

During the trading session on 28/11/2025, warrants fluctuated according to the struggling movement of the underlying stocks.

- Pulling the index up: VIC (+11.31), VPL (+2.34), VNM (+0.97), VHM (+0.37), VRE (+0.31).
- Pulling the index down: VCB (-0.92), FPT (-0.89), GEE (-0.85), BID (-0.70), HPG (-0.59).
- The matched trade value of VN-Index reached VND 18,431 billion, increased 4.56% compared to the previous session. The total transaction value reached VND 23,787 billion.
- The trading range is 17.02 points. The market had 106 gainers, 74 remaining unchanged, 185 losers.
- Foreign investors' net buying value: VND 335.79 billion on HOSE, including VNM (VND 241.59 billion), VIC (VND 130.74 billion), VIX (VND 106.18 billion), VPB (VND 99.54 billion), PVD (VND 97.38 billion). Foreign investors were net buyers on HNX with the value of VND 13.85 billion.






