

Vietnam Daily Review VN-INDEX CLOSES BELOW 1,700

Thursday, 11 December 2025

STOCK MARKET

The VN-Index continued to consolidate with a downward bias today, closing at 1,698.90 points, down more than 20 points from yesterday. Market breadth tilted negative, with 14 out of 18 sectors declining, led by Travel & Leisure, followed by Industrials. Regarding foreign flows, foreign investors were net sellers across all three exchanges—HSX, HNX, and UPCoM. The VN-Index is now pulling back to retest the SMA20; if this support level is breached, the index may retreat toward 1,680, which corresponds to the SMA50.

FUTURES CONTRACTS

Futures contracts all decreased according to the movement of VN30.

COVERED WARRANTS

During the trading session on 11/12/2025, warrants fluctuated according to the correction of the underlying stocks.

HIGHLIGHT

- VN-Index -20.08 points, closing at 1698.9 points. HNX-Index -0.61 points, closing at 255.87 points.
- Pulling the index up: SAB (+0.26), BMP (+0.24), LPB (+0.22), KBC (+0.18), FPT (+0.17).
- Pulling the index down: VIC (-2.62), VHM (-2.37), VPL (-2.01), VPB (-1.61),
 VCB (-1.22).
- The matched trade value of VN-Index reached VND 13,897 billion, decreased -8.65% compared to the previous session. The total transaction value reached VND 16,482 billion.
- The trading range is 25.12 points. The market had 104 gainers, 75 remaining unchanged, 192 losers.
- Foreign investors' net selling value: VND -493.48 billion on HOSE, including VIC (VND -192.19 billion), STB (VND -158.46 billion), VHM (VND -104.91 billion), GMD (VND -102.18 billion), VPX (VND -71.38 billion). Foreign investors were net sellers on HNX with the value of VND -17.15 billion.







The BSC50 portfolio includes 50 companies selected based on liquidity criteria among the 100 best liquid stocks on all three exchanges. These stocks have a higher beta than BSC30, but are still among the top companies in Banking, Securities, Insurance, Construction, Real Estate, Materials, Logisitic, O&G, F&B, Retail, Industrial Production, and Utilities (Electricity, Water), etc. BSC 50 is evaluated quarterly by BSC experts to ensure that the stocks still meet the given criteria. The BSC50 listing is suitable for bull market periods and has potential for investors looking for short-term trading opportunities.
