

## STOCK MARKET

VN-Index gained nearly 26 points today, closing at 1,902.93. Market breadth was positive, with 15 of 18 sectors advancing; the Oil & Gas sector led the rally, followed by Utilities. Regarding foreign trading activity, foreign investors recorded net selling across all three exchanges—HSX, HNX, and UPCOM—today. The market experienced late-session tug-of-war as it broke above the 1,900 threshold. Overall sentiment remained constructive, and the VN-Index still appears to have momentum to challenge new highs.

## FUTURES CONTRACTS

Futures contracts all increased according to the movement of VN30.

During the trading session on 13/01/2026, warrants fluctuated according to the uptrend of the underlying stocks.

## HIGHLIGHT

- VN-Index **+25.60** points, closing at **1902.93** points. HNX-Index **+0.97** points, closing at **252.85** points.
- Pulling the index up: **VIC (+7.08)**, **GAS (+3.67)**, **VHM (+3.41)**, **BID (+2.70)**, **VCB (+2.35)**.
- Pulling the index down: **MBB (-1.08)**, **TCB (-0.96)**, **MCH (-0.64)**, **ACB (-0.64)**, **HPG (-0.40)**.
- The matched trade value of VN-Index reached VND **40,065** billion, increased **1.60%** compared to the previous session. The total transaction value reached VND 42,344 billion.
- The trading range is 38.9 points. The market had **203** gainers, 39 remaining unchanged, **131** losers.
- Foreign investors' net selling value: VND **-482.66** billion on HOSE, including **GMD (VND -252.31 billion)**, **SHB (VND -184.75 billion)**, **VRE (VND -136.94 billion)**, **ACB (VND -134.27 billion)**, **STB (VND -104.91 billion)**. Foreign investors were net sellers on HNX with the value of VND **-47.03** billion.

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

### Outlook:

- VN30 +8.97 points, closing at 2089.21 points. The trading range was 24.64 points. VIC, VHM, VRE, GAS, VPB impacted positively on VN30.
- The VN30 index has maintained its positive momentum since the market opened. At the close of trading, the index rose 0.43% compared to the previous session. Market liquidity continues to remain above the MA20 line. The strategy is flexible long/short, with a preference for long positions.
- Futures contracts all increased according to the movement of VN30. In terms of volume, futures contracts increased, except for 41I1G1000, 41I1G1000.





The BSC50 portfolio includes 50 companies selected based on liquidity criteria among the 100 best liquid stocks on all three exchanges. These stocks have a higher beta than BSC30, but are still among the top companies in Banking, Securities, Insurance, Construction, Real Estate, Materials, Logistic, O&G, F&B, Retail, Industrial Production, and Utilities (Electricity, Water), etc. BSC 50 is evaluated quarterly by BSC experts to ensure that the stocks still meet the given criteria. The BSC50 listing is suitable for bull market periods and has potential for investors looking for short-term trading opportunities.

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
