Index getting back

BSC's Forecast on the stock market

Highlights

- After the opening of the first trading session of the week, the VN-Index has fallen sharply, but there had been a recovery.
- The most gainers included MSN (+0.91 points), VJC (+0.61 points), STB (+0.44 points), BHN (+0.19 points) and VNM (+0.13 points).
- \bullet The most losers included ROS (-1.13 points), SAB (-0.9 points), BID (-0.21 points), CTG (-0.17 points) and VCB (- 0.16 points).
- Cash flow declined in the steel, technology sectors and speculative stocks, cash flow rotated between the banking stocks, real estate and construction sectors. The trading value today dropped sharply reached VND 2,777.7 billion.
- The daily trading range was quite wide with 5.41 points. The market breadth was negative today with 112 gainers / 163 losers.
- Ending the trading session today, VN-Index declined 1.55 points to 805.58 points; HNX gained 0.82 points to 107.34 points.

Market outlook

The decline of liquidity to a low level in this month made market trading less excited during the session. The correction pressure from individual large-cap stocks and the loss of liquidity in most stocks caused VN-Index to test the support level of below 802 points, but the market fluctuation was quite narrow and had yet confirmed a short term correction trend. The improvement of liquidity in most sectors is necessary in upcoming sessions. Investors should be cautious in opening new position especially in stocks attracting short-term cash flow to prevent risk of market adjustment.

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Market highlights


Right after the opening of the first trading session of the week, the VN-Index dropped sharply. This was due to the fall of two large-cap stocks, ROS (declined more than VND 8,000 / share, after the ceiling session) and SAB (decline VND 16,000 per share sometimes). However, with the recovery of SAB, the rise of some major stocks has pulled back a part of the index. The most gainers included MSN (+0.91 points), VJC (+0.61 points), STB (+0.44 points), BHN (+0.19 points) and VNM (+0.13 points). Meanwhile, the most losers included ROS (-1.13 points), SAB (-0.9 points), BID (-0.21 points), CTG (-0.17 points) and VCB (-0.16 points). The market liquidity weakened for large cap stocks and speculative stocks, of which KLF, HSG, DXG, HPG, VJC had a big loss in liquidity compared to the recent trading session, cash flow weakened on the steel, technology and speculative stocks, cash flow rotated between stocks in banking, real estate and construction. While ACB, STB, and SHB were surging in terms of liquidity and price, most other stocks in the banking group were still in a correction trend and had not improved liquidity. Group Aviation, Petroleum were active, most of the market sectors weakened. The trading value today dropped sharply when it reached VND 2,777.7 billion. The trading range was guite large at 5.41 points. The market was negative today with 112 gainers / 163 losers. At the end of today trading session, the VN Index lost 1.55 points (0.19%), closed at 805.58 points. On the contrary, HNX gained 0.82 points (0.77%) to 107.34 points.

Foreigners today net sold VND 58.2 billion on the HOSE focusing on SBT (VND 39.7 billion), HSG (VND 17 billion), SSI (VND 16.8 billion). In addition, they continued to net sold VND 77.26 billion on the HNX, mainly in NTP (VND 80.9 billion) and VGC (VND1.8 billion). The market today closed with a total of 5258 contracts, the total market value reached VND 413.4 billion.

Market outlook


