Red Domination

BSC's Forecast on the stock market

Highlights

• The VN-Index had some certain corrections in the afternoon session, making the general trend of the market back to the sideways position with the domination of red color.

• The biggest gainers were SAB (+ 2.27 points), BHN (+0.57 points), VNM (+0.45 points), VCB (+0.39 points) and MSN (+0.28 points).

• The biggest losers were BID (-0.56 points), CTG (-0.34 points), PLX (-0.31 points), VIC (-0.24 points) and BVH (- 0.14 points).

• Cash flow increased due to selling pressure in market sectors such as Real Estate, Securities, and some stocks of the banking. The trading value of VN-Index was VND 3,310.6 billion.

• The daily trading range was widened to 7.25 points. The current market breadth was negative with 110 gainers / 151 losers.

• At the end of today trading session, the VN Index advanced by 1.05 points to 804.82 points, whereas the HNX declined 0.09 points to 107.43 points.

Market outlook

Though VN-Index advanced, market was still negative since losers dominated and most of gained points contributed by SAB which rose by more than VND 11.1 points with trading value of only VND 4.5 billion but largely manipulated both VN-Index and VN30-Index. However, selling pressure made the market liquidity increased. The corrections occurred on wide scale for most sectors, especially in Real estate stocks, but some small groups such as Fertilizer, Aviation and Beer recovered positively. Slight improvements in large capitalization stocks were the main factors that kept index in green. BSC keeps outlook that market had not yet improved, investors should limit proportion of stock exposure while most stocks are moving to short-term corrections.

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Market highlights

Ending the morning trading session, VN-Index recorded a quite positive momentum with the demand increased sharply, causing the blue-chip stocks to advance. Even though VN-Index increased by more than 5 points in the morning session, some corrections in the afternoon session made the general trend of the market return to the sideways with the domination of red color. The biggest gainers were SAB (+ 2.27 points), BHN (+0.57 points), VNM (+0.45 points), VCB (+0.39 points) and MSN (+ +0.28 points). Meanwhile, the biggest losers were BID (-0.56 points), CTG (-0.34 points), PLX (-0.31 points), VIC (-0.24 points) and BVH (-0.14 points). Today's market performance was largely supported by SAB, which rose sharply at the end of the morning despite a low trading value of VND 4.5 billion, however, the overall market trend was downward. The cash flow increased due to selling pressure in some sectors such as Real Estate, Securities, and some Banking stocks, while continuing to hold on average with sectors such as Transportation, Telecommunication. The trading value reached VND 3,310.6 billion. The daily trading range was widened to 7.25 points. The market breadth was negative with 110 gainers / 151 losers. At the end of the day, VN-Index increased by 1.05 points (0.13%) to 804.82 points. In contrast, the HNX lost 0.09 points (0.08% %) to 107.43 points.

Foreigners today were net buyers of VND 138 billion on HOSE, focusing on VNM (VND 24.9 billion), STB (VND 21.2 billion) and PHR (VND 16.9 billion). In addition, they continued to net sell strongly VND 137.6 billion on the HNX, mainly in NTP (VND 134 billion) and PVS (VND 10.2 billion). The derivatives market today closed with a total of 8105 contracts, the total trading value reached VND 639.9 billion.

Market outlook

Though VN-Index advanced, market was still negative since losers dominated and most of gained points contributed by SAB which rose by more than VND 11.1 points with trading value of only VND 4.5 billion but largely manipulated both VN-Index and VN30-Index. However, selling pressure made the market liquidity increased. The corrections occurred on wide scale for most sectors, especially in Real estate stocks, but some small groups such as Fertilizer, Aviation and Beer recovered positively. Slight improvements in large capitalization stocks were the main factors that kept index in green. BSC keeps outlook that market had not yet improved, investors should limit proportion of stock exposure while most stocks are moving to short-term corrections.

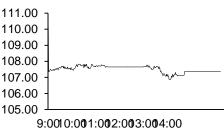

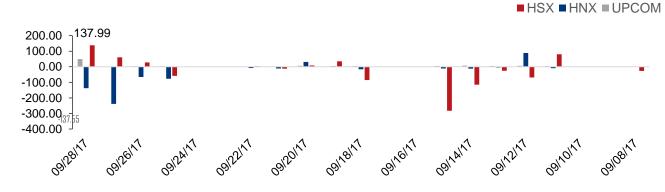
