Green overwhelming

BSC's Forecast on the stock market

Highlights

- After being sold aggressively in the previous session, the market had a recovery session.
- The leaders were GAS (+3.09 points); VCB (+1.86 points); VIC (+1.70 points); VJC (+1.45 points); BID (+1.32 points)
- The laggards were ROS (-0.24 points); HDB (-0.16 points); BMI (-0.03 points); BWE (-0.03 points); HNG (-0.02 points)
- Cash flow was concentrated in stocks (banks, real estate), helping to maintain the momentum of the index
- The trading value of VN-Index in today session reached 3,210 billion. The trading range was 25.34 points. The market recorded 217 gainers and 71 decliners.
- By the ending of the session, VN-Index increased 18.79 points, closing at 980.95 points. Moreover, HNX-Index increased 1.53 points to 112.11 points.
- Foreign investors today net sold 136.16 billion on HOSE, focusing on VHM (53.89 billion), VNM (46.04 billion) and HDB (21.35 billion). They also net sold 3.6 billion on HNX.

Market outlook

After two trading sessions were sold strongly, VN-Index had a recovery session. The market experienced little shake in the early morning session, the rise of a large number of large stocks maintained the momentum of the market in the remaining trading time. However foreigners were net selling but with average amount. BSC comments that investors' sentiment was still concerned after the sharp fall yesterday and negative external signals. BSC advises that investors should limit their use of margin until the market is in balance.

PDR_Positive accumulation, waiting for breakout signal Technical highlights:

- Current Trend: Accumulated and is compressed by SMA100 and SMA200
- MACD trend: Above 0 threshold
- RSI: Postive
- Volume: increasing 2.5 times compared to the average 20 sessions 's volume

Comment: Vibrating sharply on the session dated 19/6, PDR still had 9 cumulative 111.50 trading sessions within the recovery candle on 6/6. Today's trading is remarkable as bid volume absorbed force sell at low price. The price increase with increasing liquidity. However, the index is still being compressed by the two SMA 100 and SMA 200 trend 110.50 lines. The accumulation process can last long when the index can not overcome the 110.00 resistance from 32-32.5. Trackking PDR within the current cumulative range, exploration position could be open when price passes the resistant of 32-32.5 with good liquidity for target price of 36 in short-term.



Derivatives market

The market was active at the beginning of the session thanks to the discount status, although the volatility was only stable when the indexes maintained good recovery after 11 am. Liquidity continued to boom and set a new record with 111,177 contracts or 11,864 billion traded. The difference of the HNX-VN30 was -0.6%, -0.9%, -0.2% and 1.5% respectively. Total bid volume is equal to total bid volume; On average, a buy and sell order was equal to 3.4 contracts.

Exhibit 2 **HNX-Index Intraday**




