# **Highlights**

- VN-Index fluctuated and increased slightly in the morning session and the increase improved in the afternoon session.
- Stocks contributed to VN-Index upward momentum including VCB (+1.35 points); MSN (+1.27 points); GAS (+1.16 points); HPG (+0.9 points); PLX (+0.55 points)
- Stocks made the market decline including SAB (-0.33 points); VJC (-0.23 points); VIC (-0.09 points); VPI (-0.04 points); POW (-0.03 points)
- Cash flow focused on materials and chemicals stocks, liquidity increased slightly compared to the previous session.
- The matching value of VN-Index today reached VND 3736.3 billion. Today's trading range is 7.91 points. The market has 193 gainers and 100 losers.
- At the end of today's trading session, VN-Index increased by 7.71 points, closing at 945.25 points. The HNX-Index also increased by 0.45 points to 106.49 points.
- Foreign investors today bought a net of VND 237.5 billion on HOSE, focusing on CTI (VND 69.05 billion), VCB (VND 58.62 billion) and DXG (VND 15.18 billion). They also bought a net of VND 7.66 billion on HNX.

### Market outlook

In the morning session, VN-Index fluctuated and increased slightly due to strong cash inflows of blue-chips such as GAS, MSN, HPG, PLX, MWG and banking group like VCB, VPB, TCB, HDB. In the afternoon session, the index still gained slightly comparing to the morning session as the buying continued on VCB, MSN and GAS as well as the drop of VIC was narrowed and the gain of VNM. Foreign investors net bought strongly and liquidity continued to improve today. From BSC's point of view, the market continued to have a gaining session with market sentiment having a significant improvement after Tet holiday. Investors should keep track of macro news along with 2018 business results of companies to consider opening positions.


# **Technical Analysis** FPT Short-term rebound

# Technical highlights:

- Current trend: Short-term rebound
- MACD trend: Negative convergence, MACD crossed the center line and headed
- RSI: Neutral zone, breaking above Bollinger channel.
- MA: MA20 is likely to cut MA50 and converge with MA200.


Outlook: FPT is in the mid-term consolidation price channel of 40-46 from August 105.00 2017. The trend of short-term rebound in recent sessions is quite strong with liquidity exceeding the average of 20 sessions. This tend will cause the stock to retest the resistance level of 46 in the next few sessions; RSI and MACD indicators also support the uptrend thanks to strong breakout momentum of RSI along with the widening distance between MACD and its signal line. The movement of 3 MA lines Table 1 shows that stocks are in short-term rebound period. Thus, FPT will retest the 46 level in the next sessions. Investors can open position at 46 only if the stock surpasses this level with a large price increase and high liquidity.


