Continue excited momentum

Highlights

- VN-Index increased strongly in the morning. In the afternoon, the gaining momentum was widened.
- Stocks contributed to VN-Index upward momentum including GAS (+1.6 points); SAB (+1.15 points); VCB (+1.11 points); VNM (+0.99 points); VIC (+0.57 points).
- Stocks made the market decline including ROS (-0.22 points); HT1 (-0.06 points); VPB (-0.04 points); MBB (-0.03 points); PME (-0.03 points).
- The matching value of VN-Index today reached VND 3,058.8 billion. Today's trading range is 12.66 points. The market has 171 gainers and 117 losers.
- At the end of today's trading session, VN-Index increased 10.65 points to close at 987.13 points. At the same time, HNX-Index increased 0.52 points to 106.31 points.
- Foreign investors today sold a net of VND 29.95 billion on HOSE, focusing on PVD (37.4 billion), SAB (16.5 billion) and VHM (15.9 billion). In addition, they bought a net of VND 42.93 billion on HNX.

Market outlook

VN-Index in the morning increased compared to the previous session, ending the morning session, the VN-Index increased 5.47 points or 0.56%. The stocks which supported the market the most, were GAS, VCB, SAB.. In the afternoon, the gaining trend was widened thanks to the gain of petrolium stocks like PVD, GAS, PLX and bluechips like VCB, SAB, VNM, and VIC continued gaining. However, foreign investors were net sellers on HOSE today. From BSC's point of view, the market continued to recover, the market liquidity was positive, showing that investors' sentiment improved and more attention was paid to stocks and stocks with information to support accumulation.

Technical Analysis

PNJ Breakout

Technical highlights:

- Current trend: break out in the short term and keep the uptrend in the medium term
- Trend indicator MACD: uptrend, above the center line and above the signal line.
- RSI indicator: in the overbought zone
- MA line: MA lines continue the uptrend.

Outlook: PNJ is moving in price channel 103.7 - 108.77. RSI indicator in the overbought zone supports short-term break-through status. MACD indicator continued to show that PNJ's price range will be likely to continue its uptrend in the next sessions. The movement of all MA lines continued to move up and the liquidity increased sharply to surpass the average level of 20 sessions. Therefore, PNJ will continue the short-term breakout and keep the uptrend in the medium term. The resistance of PNJ is 110.63 and the support at 98.89 and 101.22. It is possible to open short-term position in the price range of 104 - 108.3, take profit at the price of 110 - 114.13 and cut loss if PNJ loses 102.7.




