Market outlook

Stock market: VN-Index opened the session losing 20 points because the negative selling pressure from yesterday was still there, but when the index touched MA50, cash flows caught the bottom helping VN-Index back to trade around the reference area. In the afternoon session, VN-Index surged thanks to the support from VN30, but then the index was quickly overwhelmed by sellers and dropped back to reference until the end of the session. Notably, liquidity was a big minus point today, maybe because the investors were tired of the dramatic movements of the market. Market breadth tilted to the negative side with 9 out of 19 sectors gaining. However, foreign investors were the bright spot when they were net buyers on both HSX and HNX, especially today was the biggest net buying session within the past month. Closing at MA20 with weak liquidity, VN-Index is likely to retest MA50 before reaching the supply-demand balance to continue its uptrend.

Future contracts: Futures contracts all dropped in line with the movement of the VN30. Investors should trade cautiously in the coming sessions.

Covered warrants: In the trading session on January 14, 2022, most warrants dropped sharply following the movement of the underlying stock.

- VN-Index -0.03 points, closing 1,496.02 points. HNX-Index +6.03 points, closing 466.86 points.
- Pulling the index up: VCB (+1.81), VNM (+0.85), POW (+0.48), CTG (+0.37), VRE (+0.35).
- Pulling the index down: DIG (-0.90), NVL (-0.74), TCB (-0.67), HPG (-0.51), BCM (-0.50).
- The matching value of VN-Index reached VND 20,953 billion, down 29.0% compared to the previous session. The total transaction value reached VND 22,867 billion.
- The fluctuation range is 26 points. The market had 174 gainers, 54 reference stocks and 285 losers.
- Foreign investors' net buying value: VND 770.53 billion on HOSE, including FUEVFVND (VND 120.69 billion), STB (VND 118.12 billion), VNM (VND 81.26 billion). Foreign investors were net buyers on HNX with the value of VND 11.19 billion.

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Technical Analysis NBC_Rebound

Technical highlights:

- Current Trend: Rebound.
- MACD trend indicator: Positive divergence, MACD crosses the signal line
- RSI indicator: neutral zone, uptrend.

Outlook: NBC is forming a rebounding trend after recovering from the bottom level of 15.0. Stock liquidity has surpassed the average trading threshold of 20 sessions, in alignment with the stock's uptrend. The MACD and the RSI are both backing this uptrend. The stock price line has also crossed the MA20 and is approaching to test the MA50, showing that an uptrend is gradually forming. Investors can open a position at 17.4, take profit at 19.7 and cut loss if the stock drops to 16.5.







Outlook:

- VN30 dropped 2.86 points to 1523.57 points. Stocks like TCB, VPB, HPG, NVL, MWG, ACB negatively impacted VN30's movement. Today's correction continued to reinforce the accumulation trend of VN30. This trend is expected to continue in the coming sessions.
- Futures contracts all dropped in line with the movement of the VN30. In terms of trading volume, futures contracts VN30F2206 and VN30FV30F2201 decreased, while the other two futures contracts increased. In terms of open positions, the contract VN30F2206 and VN30F2201 decreased, the contract VN30D2203 increased slightly and the contract VN30F2202 remained unchanged from the previous session. The index of contracts moved in the down direction and the number of open interest decreased, showing that the cash flow is tending to exit the market. Investors should trade cautiously in the coming sessions.

Outlook:

- In the trading session on January 14, 2022, most warrants dropped sharply following the movement of the underlying stock.
- CPNJ2201 and CMWG2114 saw the best growth, 31.82% and 19.68% respectively. Transaction value plummeted -57.06%. CTPB2201 has the most transaction value, accounting for 8.09% of the market.
- CVHM2113, CMWG2109, CMSN2107, and CMWG2201 are the warrants with value closest to the theoretical price. CPDR2103, CVHM2110, CVHM2112 and CPNJ2106 are the most positive warrants in terms of returns. CMWG2104, CMWG2109 and CKDH2104 are the most positive warrants in terms of money position.


